



## **SUBMISSION RULES:**

**Submission deadline is close of business (5:00PM) Friday, June 26, 2015.** There is no entry fee.

One submission form per video entry. Submitters name and the production title must be included, along with a 100 word or less summary of the entry. Productions will not be considered unless accompanied by the necessary entry form.

A maximum of three entries per individual submitter.

All productions must have been created by or with assistance from the submitter. No paid/compensated or previously broadcast productions are eligible.

Productions submitted must have been completed in the past 24 months, using the submission deadline as the time measure.

## **CATEGORIES:**

Drama - Comedy - Documentary - Animation - Music Video

## **ENTRY SPECIFICATIONS:**

Entries may be submitted as either a DVD Video or video file (H.264 Quicktime file preferred). Entries may be on DVD or a flash drive, clearly labeled to accompany the submission form.

All entries must be in English or contain English subtitles.

Duration of video is limited to a maximum of 20 minutes. If the total run time of the production is greater than 20 minutes, then an excerpt no greater than 20 minutes can be used for submission.

Entries submitted will not be returned.

## **ABOUT THE 3 RIVERS FILM FESTIVAL:**

The 3 Rivers Film Festival will combine a public showcase of local talent with a television broadcast event.

**Selected entries will be presented for public viewing as part of the 3 Rivers Film Festival event at the Cinema Center on Wednesday, July 15 at 8:00PM & 10:00PM.**

Some of those entries will then be broadcast on PBS39 after the premiere screening. The submitters and the public will be notified of the entries selected for the Cinema Center and for broadcast on PBS39 by July 6, 2015. Notification of the official broadcast date will be provided closer to the event. To be eligible to be selected for the broadcast presentation, your submission cannot contain any material that would violate the FCC broadcast rules and regulations for profanity and indecency.

Submissions are reviewed for technical and message merit by the broadcast staff at PBS39.

By submitting to the 3 Rivers Film Festival, you are agreeing to allow PBS39 and its affiliates to utilize submitted productions for broadcast and web use, as well as promotional purposes, in perpetuity.
